「綠精靈」種植計劃



龐比度中心建於1977年。意大利建築師Renzo Piano及英國建築師Richard Rogers

合力設計而成，並以法國總統龐比度的名字來命名。單看其建築物外型已覺非常前衛，全都以鋼鐵玻璃來構造，四周塗上不同顏色的鋼管道，據講藍色代表空調系統，綠色代表水管，黃色代表電線系統。這種大膽而富創意的構思，在當時以或至今日的建築界來講都是矚目震撼的，歎怪它能成為巴黎的重要地標所在。

發掘更多 龐比度



藝術教育，由生活出發這場視覺盛宴組成自多位當代歐洲藝術大師。同學邊觀賞邊想像藝術家與作品中的模特兒有著怎麼樣耐人尋味的故事。同學們討論《大宮女》畫面頂部的蒼蠅，紅與綠的大膽塗抹帶來強烈的對比。畢加索的《小丑》畫像為什麼會面容憂鬱凝重，眼神悲傷。老師指著克利的《鐵匠》問：「你看到畫面裡有什麼呢？」同學脫口而出：「巫婆、船、警察叔叔、三角形……」看來，小朋友更能駕馭想象的翅膀，天馬行空。飽覽二十世紀世界級藝術珍品的流光溢彩後，為了帶出藝術家不斷推翻傳統、創新求變的創造精神，老師鼓勵同學從展覽中的「繆斯」、「變奏」、「夢幻」、「友誼」和「模仿」等主題，選出所能產生共鳴的，便在學校牆壁上來一次大合奏。你有否發現同學們亦能表現出「立體主義」的分解、重構，「表現主義」的激蕩，「超現實主義」的夢幻與迷離，「普普派」的色彩及張揚。
